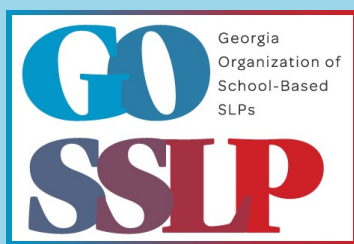

Exploring Vocabulary and Morphology Interventions and Strategies (Preschool - Adolescents)

Cathy Alexander, MA, CCC-SLP

This conference provides speech-language pathologists (SLPs) the ability to foster vocabulary development by embedding evidence-based practices within activities. Learn two approaches for selecting target vocabulary words and nine techniques for teaching vocabulary. Numerous "Ready-to-use" activities from preschool age through adolescents will be provided. The strong and reciprocal relationship between reading comprehension and vocabulary development will be discussed.

In addition, the workshop will explore a "Morphological Activity Toolbox" targeted for the young child through adolescents. Grammatical morphology instruction will provide strategies and activities for the preschool age and elementary age child. These strategies will target regular plurals, irregular plurals, and verb tenses. In addition, prefix, suffix, and root word activities will be demonstrated. Attendees will learn 80+ morphological activities.

Objectives:

- Objective 1: The participant will be able to define and describe two evidence-based strategies for selecting vocabulary targets.
- Objective 2: The participant will be able to list, define, and describe two evidence-based strategies to teach vocabulary.
- Objective 3: The participant will be able to list, define, and describe four evidence-based strategies to teach grammatical morphology and four evidence-based strategies to teach prefixes, suffixes, and root word.

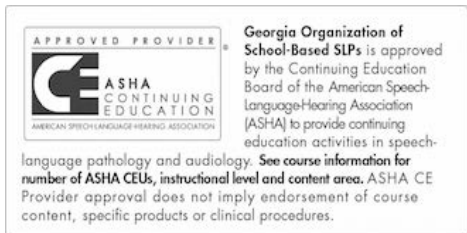
